The Cooper Trooper Foundation is a 501c3, non-profit foundation, committed to total family treatment when a child is diagnosed with cancer.

Our mission includes:

1. Distribution of FREE Courage Kits (a knapsack with items that are specifically designed for the **well siblings of children diagnosed with cancer**). Often, the well brothers and sisters of a child with cancer, can feel left out in the midst of treatment. CTF strives to celebrate and remind these "Heroes in the Shadows" that they are not forgotten.
2. Funding Research that is specific to Childhood Cancers.



PUMPKIN PATCH

Every October, The Cooper Trooper Foundation holds their primary fundraiser- the Pumpkin Patch. Sponsors like you, help make this happen. Your sponsorship covers our expenses, allowing 100% of the money raised to go directly to the foundation.
